Feed My Sheep Update:

November will mark the 4 year anniversary of the beginning of Feed My Sheep Outreach in downtown Canton. We started with a pot and 8 cups of coffee out of the back of a van, then added mittens, hats and socks. We soon were spreading the Gospel to 75+ people every Saturday. In January of 2020, we moved indoors to a location offered to us by Crossroads United Methodist Church, with all the resources we had been praying for (bathrooms, electricity, storage for our supplies, and a place to collect items needed by those we serve).

Now we are growing again! As of October 2021, Feed My Sheep is partnering with the Canton Free Store and Fresh Market and the Akron-Canton Food Bank to run the store each Saturday from 7:00-10:00am. The fresh market offers items such as meat, dairy, baked goods, and fresh produce. Also, rooms will be stocked with housewares, clothing/shoes (for adults and children), cleaning/laundry supplies and hygiene items. These items are much needed but not typically found in pantries or clothing banks.

What does this all mean as far as hot food? We have a list of hot meals in the area for anyone needing that option. We will still have coffee and sweets for anyone coming in. We know most of them by name and will continue to encourage and build relationships with them.

What will Feed My Sheep volunteers be doing on Saturdays? Stocking food, running a food or clothing department, accepting donations at the door, helping shoppers, or maybe organizing and stocking the shopping rooms. There is always something to be done, and we are always looking for folks to drink coffee and commune with those who enter the doors. This is a great way to help.
